JOB TITLE: Community Educator (Part-time)

Vetri Community Partnership is seeking an engaging Community Educator who will lead cooking demonstrations and classes, recipe samplings, and nutrition education activities for kids, adults, and families across Philadelphia and Camden. The goal of the Educator is to inspire community members to include nutritious foods in meals for themselves and their families. The Community Educator will drive and operate VCP's Mobile Teaching Kitchen in the community to deliver recipe samplings in public spaces including farmers' markets, schools, and food distributions and will lead and support cooking classes in VCP's Teaching Kitchen.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Lead indoor and outdoor cooking and nutrition education activities for individuals and groups across the Philadelphia region; shifts range from 4-8 hours; Saturdays and some Sundays required
- Drive and operate VCP's Mobile Teaching Kitchens, our modified food trucks, to/and from program delivery sites
- Independently manage the prep, set-up, instruction, and break-down of each class or experience
- Prepare lessons for varying event structures and make on-site decisions regarding set-up and program delivery
- Assist in the cleaning and maintenance of VCP's Teaching Kitchen and a 3-truck fleet of Mobile Teaching Kitchens including fueling, scheduled service, and cleaning of both truck and equipment
- Communicate effectively with supervisor and site liaisons regarding logistics and scheduling
- Ensure program fidelity in the implementation of VCP curriculum, goals, and mission

EXPERIENCE AND REQUIREMENTS

- Knowledge of basic cooking techniques; strong knife skills preferred
- Knowledge of and curiosity to continue learning about food, cooking, and related topics
- Strong interpersonal skills; Experience teaching or leading classes or demonstrations a plus
- Comfortable providing cooking demonstrations in both indoor and outdoor settings within diverse communities
- Applicants with Spanish language skills are encouraged to apply
- Must be available on Saturdays
- Ability to work independently and demonstrate creative problem-solving skills
- Passion for our mission of nourishing minds, bodies, and communities with nutrition education through cooking
- Must have a valid driver's license and the ability to drive a company vehicle
