



IMPROVING HEALTH OUTCOMES WITH CULINARY MEDICINE

Vetri Community Partnership partnered with top medical schools in Philadelphia to integrate culinary medicine into their curriculums, equipping future physicians with essential skills to address the nutritional aspects of patient care.

COOKING FOR HEART HEALTH

Patient-centered cooking classes, like our new Cooking for Heart Health Series, were piloted to engage the public in developing and enhancing their cooking skills using recipes tailored to support specific nutritional needs. The goal of these classes is to help prevent diet-related conditions, including cardiovascular disease, through food as medicine approaches.

COMMUNITY COOKING CLASSES

Joanne had been searching for cooking classes to do with her two daughters, Bella (11) and Aleyah (14), for years before they came to Vetri Community Partnership's Teaching Kitchen.

The family's first visit was part of a field trip for students across our region who are enrolled in cyber and homeschool programs. Joanne, Bella, and Aleyah enjoyed the experience so much that they began attending VCP's Community Cooking Classes, which are free to the public and take place every other Tuesday evening.

Joanne said, "At the Community Cooking Classes, Aleyah and Bella have been exposed to new recipes and ingredients that I wouldn't normally make at home. Their growing knife skills and passion for cooking have inspired me to spend more time in the kitchen with them.

"We are all eating more veggies now!"

For Joanne, the best part of Community Cooking Nights is the quality time spent with her daughters and niece, learning about new foods while connecting with others in the class. As for surprises? Joanne chuckles,

"Ratatouille! I didn't even realize it was a real dish—I thought it was just a movie!"




Revenue
